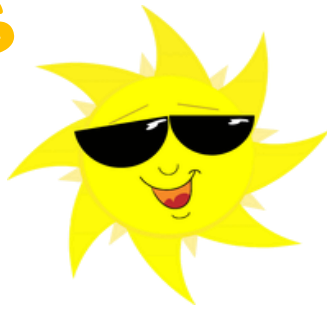

We are incredibly excited to be bringing back Sunny Days Summer Camp at St. Katharine Drexel School for another fun-filled summer! Our goal is that your child has a positive and engaging experience while meeting new friends and having fun!

Registration forms must be completed in full. A registration fee of \$25.00 per family is due upon registration. All registrations are on a first-come, first-serve basis. Camp balances are due two weeks before attendance for that specific week. (Example: If you are attending camp the week of June 21st, payment for that week is due by Monday, June 7th).

Camp begins on Monday, June 21st, and ends on Friday, August 13th. We will be closed on Friday, July 2nd, and Monday, July 5th. Our hours of operation are 9:00 am to 3:00 pm. We offer extended Care for an additional hourly fee. Extended Care in the morning runs from 7:00 am to 9:00 am and in the afternoon from 3:00 pm to 4:30 pm.

Sunny Days Fact Sheet

Tuition Rates

- Full-Day Camp, 5 Days (9:00am to 3:00pm) \$150.00
- Mini Camp, 5 Days (9:00am to 12:00pm or 12:00 to 3:00pm) \$125.00
- Day Rate (Two-day minimum) \$60.00
- Before and After Care \$10.00 per hour.

Hour of Operation

- Monday, June 21st – Friday, August 13th
- Camp will be closed Friday, July 2nd, and Monday, July 5th
- Camp Hours: 9:00 am to 3:00 pm
- Mini Camp Hours: 9:00am to 12:00pm or 12:00pm to 3:00pm
- Extended Care Hours: 7:00am to 9:00am and 3:00pm to 4:30pm

Camp Location

Our base of operations is the St. Francis Center on the Pre-k side of the building located on the grounds of St. Katharine Drexel Catholic School.

Ages Our Camp Is For

Our program is open to children ages 3 years to those who have just completed 3rd grade. Your children must be 100% toilet trained and independent in the bathroom to come to our camp.

***If your child has continuous bathroom accidents, we will ask you to make other arrangements for your child this summer.

Communication

Before the start of camp, parents will be invited to join the Remind App. This how you will be contacted individually and as a group throughout camp. It is also how you can contact the camp director.

***Please note that messages sent after 7:00 pm will not be responded to until after 7:00 am the following day.

Drop Off/Pick up Procedure

Drop off for regular camp hours begins at 9:00 am and run until 9:15 am at the Pre-k building. A camp staff member will meet you and your child at the bottom of the ramp to check your child in and escort them into the building.

Pick up for regular camp hours is 3:00 pm. At this time, a camp staff member will bring the campers down the ramp and release the children to their parents.

Extended Care

Those dropping off or picking up their child before or after regular camp hours need to come to the Pre-k Building door located on the left side of St. Francis Center and ring the bell.

Dress Code

Children should come to camp wearing their bathing suits under their clothing. Clothing should be appropriate for play and recreation. Please make sure that your child wears socks and sneakers each day. Flip flops may only be worn at water play.

Campers Supplies

Each day your child should come with a backpack, a towel, sunscreen, a change of clothes, a water bottle, and a morning snack. If your child is a full-day camper, they will need lunch as well. If your child is joining us for Extended Care in the afternoon, they will need an afternoon snack too.

*** Please label all your child's belongings.

Sunscreen

Please be sure to apply sunscreen to your child every day before coming to camp. They will be spending a fair amount of the camp day outdoors. We will reapply your child's sunscreen before water play. There is NO sharing sunscreen between campers unless they are siblings.

Behavior Expectations

Children are expected to follow camp rules and behave respectfully. Behavior problems will not be tolerated. Children who fail to comply will be dismissed from the program.
