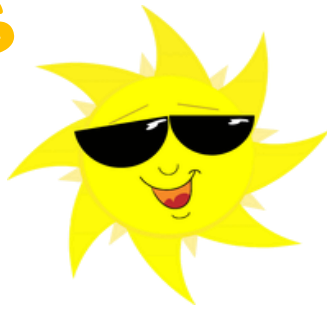

## **Sunny Days Fact Sheet**

### **Tuition Rates**

- Full-Day Camp, 5 Days (9:00am to 3:00pm) \$170.00
- Mini Camp, 5 Days (9:00am to 12:00pm or 12:00 to 3:00pm) \$145.00
- We require a two-week minimum to attend our camp

### **Hour of Operation**

- Monday, June 27<sup>th</sup> – Friday, August 19<sup>th</sup>
- Camp will be closed Monday, July 4<sup>th</sup>, and Tuesday, July 5<sup>th</sup>
- Camp Hours: 9:00 am to 3:00 pm
- Mini Camp Hours: 9:00am to 12:00pm or 12:00pm to 3:00pm

### **Camp Location**

Our base of operations is the St. Francis Center on the Pre-k side of the building located on the grounds of St. Katharine Drexel Catholic School.

### **Ages Our Camp Is For**

Our program is open to St. Katharine Drexel Students who have completed Pre-k 3 to those who have just completed 3rd grade. Your children must be 100% toilet trained and independent in the bathroom to come to our camp.

\*\*\*If your child has continuous bathroom accidents, we will ask you to make other arrangements for your child this summer.

### **Communication**

Before the start of camp, parents will be invited to join the Remind App. This is how you will be contacted individually and as a group throughout camp and how you can contact the camp director.

\*\*\*Please note that messages sent after 5:00 pm will not be responded to until after 7:00am the following day. Messages sent on the weekend will not be responded to until Monday morning after 7:00am.

### **Drop Off/Pick up Procedure**

Drop off for camp begins at 9:00 am and runs until 9:15 am at the Pre-k building. A camp staff member will meet you and your child at the bottom of the ramp to check your child in and escort them into the building.

Pick up for camp is at 3:00 pm. At this time, a camp staff member will bring the campers down the ramp and release the children to their parents.

### **Dress Code**

Children should come to camp wearing their bathing suits under their clothing. Clothing should be appropriate for play and recreation such as t-shirt and shorts. Please make sure that your child wears socks and sneakers each day no flip flops.

### **Campers Supplies**

Each day your child should come with a backpack, a towel, sunscreen, a change of clothes, a water bottle, and a morning snack. If your child is a full-day camper, they will need lunch as well.

\*\*\* Please label all your child's belongings.

### **Sunscreen**

Please be sure to apply sunscreen to your child every day before coming to camp. They will be spending a fair amount of the camp day outdoors. We will reapply your child's sunscreen before water play. There is NO sharing sunscreen between campers unless they are siblings.

### **Behavior Expectations**

Children are expected to follow camp rules and behave respectfully. Behavior problems will not be tolerated. Children who fail to comply will be dismissed from the program.
