Tuition Rates

- Full-Day Camp, 5 Days (9:00 am to 3:00 pm) \$225.00
- Mini Camp, 5 Days (9:00 am to 12:00 pm) \$125.00
- We require a two-week minimum to attend our camp
- Cares\$10.00 per hour

Hour of Operation

- Monday, June 19th – Friday, August 4th
- Camp will be closed Monday, July 3rd, and Tuesday, July 4th
- Camp Hours: 9:00 am to 3:00 pm
- Mini Camp Hours: 9:00 am to 12:00 pm
- CARES Hours: 8:00 am to 9:00 am and 3:00 pm to 4:00 pm

Camp Location

Our base of operations is the St. Francis Center on the Pre-k side of the building located on the grounds of St. Katharine Drexel Catholic School.

Requirements to attend Sunny Days

To attend Sunny Days summer camp, your child must be enrolled at SKD for the 2023/2024 school year.

Due to the demand from our school community for spots at Sunny Days, we cannot take siblings of SKD students who do not attend our school.

Ages Our Camp Is For

Our program is open to St. Katharine Drexel Students who have completed Pre-k 3 to those who have just finished 3rd grade.

Your children must be 100% toilet trained and independent in the bathroom to come to our camp.

***If your child has continuous bathroom accidents, we will ask you to make other arrangements for your child this summer.

Communication

Before the start of camp, parents will be invited to join the ClassDojo App. This is how you will be contacted individually and as a group throughout camp and how you can contact the camp director.

***Please note that messages sent after 5:00 pm will not be responded to until after 7:00 am the following day. Additionally, messages sent on the weekend will be responded to on Monday morning after 7:00 am.

Drop Off/Pick up Procedure.

Camp drop-off begins at 9:00 am and runs until 9:15 am at the Pre-k building.

Pick up for camp is 3:00 pm. At this time, a camp staff member will bring the campers down the ramp and release the children to their parents.

If you need an early pick-up or will arrive late, message us through the ClassDojo App.

Dress Code

Children should come to camp wearing their bathing suits under their clothing. Clothing should be appropriate for play and recreation, such as a t-shirt and shorts.

Please ensure that your child wears socks and sneakers daily.

Campers Supplies

Each day your child should come with a backpack, a towel, sunscreen, a change of clothes, a water bottle, and a morning snack. If your child is a full-day camper, they will also need lunch.

If your child attends before or after CARES, please provide them with a separate snack.

*** Please label all your child's belongings.

Sunscreen

Please apply sunscreen to your child every day before coming to camp. They will be spending a fair amount of the camp day outdoors. We will reapply your child's sunscreen before water play. There is only sharing sunscreen between campers if they are siblings.

Behavior Expectations

Children are expected to follow camp rules and behave respectfully. Behavior problems will not be tolerated. Children who fail to comply will be dismissed from the program.
